Hells to One and All

Will crank off early on this letter in anticipation of the envelope arriving soon. Guess we and our children will be telling tall tales for years about the hardships and records set in winter 76-77. That is if the future doesn't bring more "records". Carl, you and Hannie can sit back and quietly chuckle - cause your area is probably setting records in the opposite direction. Last night was a real pip! I went out at 6:00pm for cigs, beer, and coffee, all quiet, a balmy 43°. Back about 15 minutes later - then John left to go sledding. Five minutes later all Hell broke loose, terrific wind, lightning and thunder, John returned slightly shook up. Started checking thermometer (could literally see needle moving) like 4° drop in 2-3 minutes. At 7pm it was 26°, at 7:50pm was 18°, at 8:30pm was 15°, at 9:00pm 13°, and at 10pm was 11° (I stopped watching!). Wind was gusting up to 50 mph blowing salt off roads as crews tried to put it down. To flavor things, a progression of rain, snow, sleet fell, and as I went to bed the Moon peeked through! Roads were "like glass" and slick as greased Owl manure. The kids were pushing cars up incline from main road to our intersection where it flattens out - including one police car which "spun out". Today, Sun is out - brilliant blue sky - around 20°. Lately we have been to 0° and two-three day periods of 0 to 10, and lot of time in teens. Have had 3" of snow on ground for last month. Fortunately most of snows have come straight down - so no drifting - or some places would be 2 to 3 ft deep by now! Delaware has declared that gas will be limited to homes - enough to keep pipes from freezing, and some possibilities of total shut off. Some industries are already closed down. If it gets any worse, some families may have to double up - i.e. close down every other house (that's my idea of how to handle it anyway. We did just that with a couple families in the 50's when an ice storm shut off all electricity. We got in the car and rode around for awhile just to get warm. (As you see - my blue pen ran fresh out of juice!))

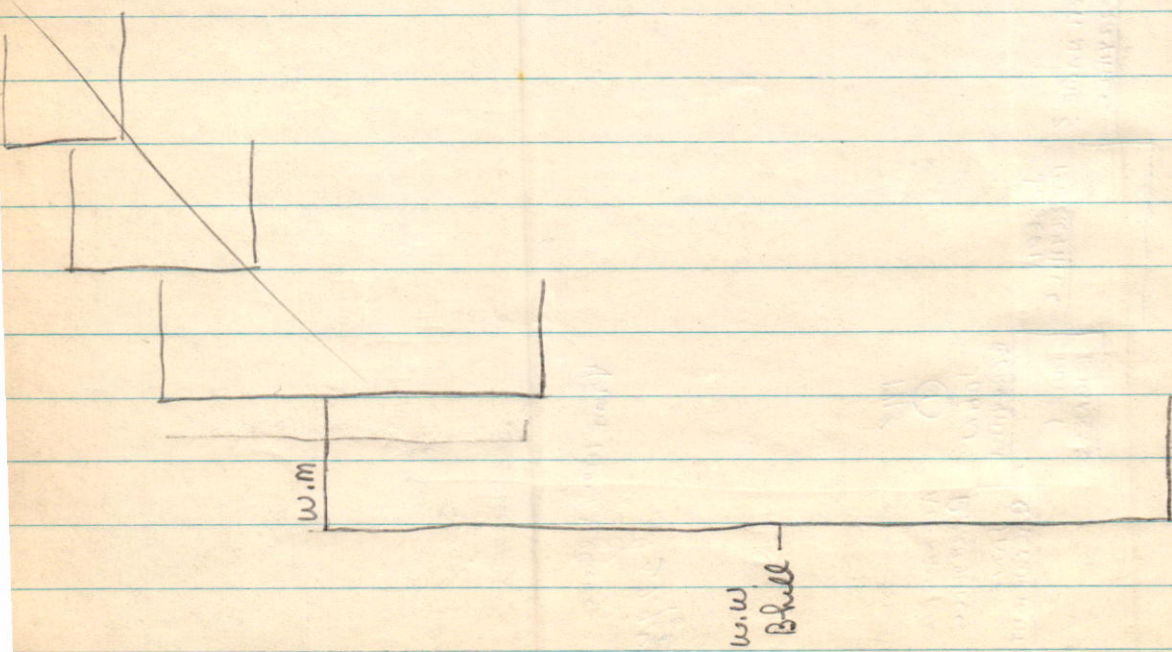

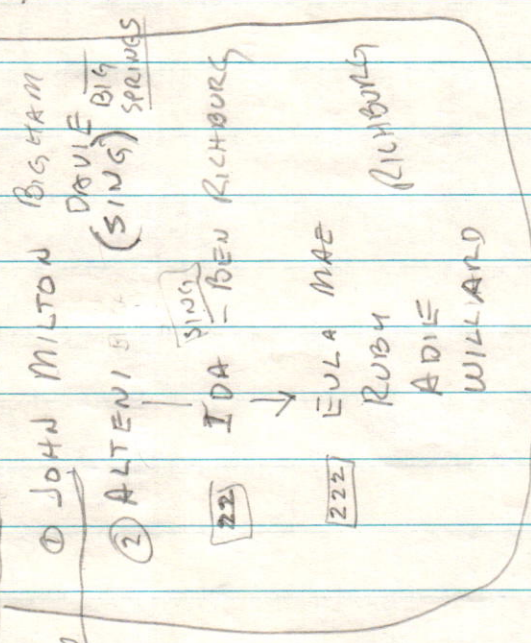
